

Workshop information

Studio 2, Hotwalls Studios, Broad St, POI 2FS

This tufting workshop is perfect for all abilities, beginners included! You will be taught how to use a tufting gun in the workshop.

Currently due to capacity and size, I can only fit a maximum of two people in my studio at a time (not including myself).

There are two workshops available. 1-to-1 sessions (£150), or a workshop for two (£90pp). Both sessions are 4 hours.

Costs include all materials.

You must be over 18 to attend a workshop, or 14+ with a responsible adult present.

What you will make

- You will have a 45cmx45m space.
- In this you can make a mini rug, wall hanging, some coasters... whatever you like!
- You will be given time to practise on a separate blank area with the gun before starting your piece.
- This is a tufting-focused workshop. Once you have tufted your design, I will back and finish your piece after. You will be able to pick up your work within 3 weeks and emailed once ready to collect.

Ahead of workshops

- Please bring water/refreshments with you.
- Long hair must be tied back.
- Please wear comfy clothes. We will be using sharp materials, so don't wear anything precious.
- Full payment is to be taken upon booking.

On the day

- Your 4 hours starts at time of booking. If you are late this will be taken off your total time.
- To make the most of your time, please arrive promptly, as you session will begin at the time of your booking.
- If the session isn't long enough for you, feel free to book an additional session.
- You will be trained on how to use the tufting gun and be run through health and safety on the day.
- To break up the session, there will be a 15-minute break within the 4 hours.

Designs

- I recommend keeping your design relatively simple, with block shapes and colours and minimal lining. Lots of detail can be challenging for beginners and takes a long time, likely overrunning your workshop.
- I would advise you to think of a design ahead of time and come with some ideas.
- You will have a wide range of colours to pick from.
- I will provide basic templates if you wish to use.
- You are welcome to send in your design ahead of time, as I can draw up on frame before you arrive so you can make the most of your workshop.
- If you are unsure, please feel free to send your ideas ahead of time and I can give you feedback.

Your booking

- You must be over 18 to attend a workshop, or 14+ with a responsible adult present.
- If you wish to cancel or amend your booking, you must give a 7-day notice.
- You will not be granted a refund if you cancel or amend the booking after the 7-day notice period.
- Unless agreed, if you do not show or cancel less than 7-days in advance, you will be charged for the full booking.
- Please remember I am a small business and cancellations/not turning up can massively affect me. Please make sure you can attend the date and time you have chosen.
- Please arrive 10-minutes before your session begins, so you can take full advantage of your session.

Health and safety

- You will be trained on how to use the equipment. By booking this workshop, you agree to be fully responsible for any injuries sustained during and from your workshop.
- Please ensure you also read through the liability waiver.
- Equipment used has vibrating motions. I do not recommend if you are pregnant, have any injuries, disabilities or health/medical conditions that may be affected by this.
- The workshop uses sharp tools including the tufting gun.

After your workshop

- I aim to have your finished tufted work ready within 3-weeks.
- You will be emailed once your work is ready to collect.
- You will need to collect during my open hours, which are updated monthly on my Instagram page.
